The Contraception and Sexual Health (CASH) Clinics, offer a range of services as follows:

- Oral contraception
- Contraceptive injection
- Emergency contraception
- Pregnancy tests
- Fitting and removing coils (IUDs)
- Fitting and checking caps and diaphragms
- Fitting and removing contraceptive implants
- Supply of condoms
- Unplanned pregnancy advice and referral
- Cervical screening (smear tests)
- Advice on gynaecological problems e.g. sexually-transmitted infections, menopause symptoms, psychosexual problems, complex contraception issues

Some services e.g. fitting of coils and contraceptive implants may only be carried out at certain centres, but the initial appointment and assessment can take place at any of the clinic locations.

Patients who may require the insertion of a coil as emergency post-coital contraception (this can be an option for up to 5 days after unprotected sex) should ring any of the CASH Clinic numbers as soon as possible for further advice.
